

of little consequence, of which there was not a sufficient quantity in store to complete them fully. The Requisition for the Mepunga purchases is completely executed; By the Requisition I observe that those goods were to be charged at the Montreal Prices; the current advance at Montreal on Indian goods is 50 percent on the striking cost, at 12 Month Credit, but, as I apprehend, it is not the intention of Government to make a profit on goods, I have charged the prices in the Invoice at an advance of 33 1/3 percent, which is nearly what I think the goods stand in debtors here, allowing for Insurance at the common Rate; which I hope Her Honor will approve of.
