Sir:-

Referring to your letter of January 13th, addressed to L.M. Dennis, Asst. to President, C.P.R., Montreal, in reference to small portion of land at Brockett in the Peigan Indian Reserve, I beg to say that your letter has been referred to me, and that the Company would be willing to sell part of the land which you require, but we would have to retain 250 feet measured at right angles from the centre line on the South side of the track.

I might say that we would be willing to release your Department extra land both at Brockett and at Peigan Siding, retaining only 150 feet on the North side of the centre line and 250 feet on the South side of the centre line through the station grounds as shown on the registered plan. This could either be arranged as a sale or an exchange of property. I understand that there is likely to be some change of line which will affect certain portions of the Peigan Indian Reserve, and it might be as well if you allow this matter to stand for a short time until the Railway Company's plans are fully matured, when possibly an
