Copy of an Order-in-Council approved by His Honour  
the Lieutenant Governor, the 1st day of December, A.D.1910.

Upon consideration of the report of the Honourable the  
Minister of Lands, Forests and Mines, dated 25th November, 1910,  
the Committee of Council advise that the following parcel of land  
containing thirty nine acres situate west of and adjacent to the  
Abitibi Indian Reserve south of Lake Abitibi, in the District of  
Hepissing, and more particularly described as follows, that is to  
say:- Commencing at the north west angle of the Township of Milligan  
thence east astronomically 40 chains to the west limit of the Abitibi  
Indian Reserve; thence north astronomically along said limit 10 chains  
18 links, more or less to the waters edge of Lake Abitibi; thence  
westerly along the water's edge of said Lake to a point due north  
of the place of beginning; thence south astronomically 13 chains  
more or less to the place of beginning as shown tinted red on plan  
attached hereto, dated 25th November, 1910, be vested in His Majesty  
King George the Fifth as represented by the Superintendent General  
of Indian Affairs in trust for the Abitibi Band of Indians
