Sir,-

I beg to enclose for your information a copy of a letter which has this day been sent to Mr. J. J. Bedard, in charge of the road-work on the Sarnia Indian Reserve.

A cheque for \$400.00 is being sent you to day.


It is to be noted especially that a separate receipt must be had for the \$2.93, balance of the \$300.00 voted by the band last year, and that of the \$500.00 advanced about the 2nd September your pay-sheets amount to \$474.73, leaving a balance of \$25.27. Mr. Bedard states that his work not paid for on the front road amounts to \$197.99. It would therefore appear that your outstanding accounts are \$169.79. This will be the first charge against the above mentioned cheque of \$400.00. Then Mr. Bedard will have the troughs put in and the balance of money will be used in grading at an opportune time.

At the same time that Mr. Bedard is having the troughs put in he should proceed with the repair of the culverts which have been washed out.

A separate letter of instructions is being sent him in this regard, a copy of which will be forwarded to you.

You will note that another advance of \$500.00 on account of the construction of these culverts is being sent you
