I receive his cheque with the other monthly salaries. The Chief decided to increase his salary to \$500⁰⁰ per annum from ^{the} January past making an increase of \$100⁰⁰ per annum. When ^{late} Chief Johnson was interpreted he received \$600⁰⁰ per annum. I consider the Rep worth of the increase. He is often required to attend at Caledonia and Cayuga to interpret for members of this nation and frequently obliged to defray his expenses. He is a married man and has two children. I beg to recommend that you approve of the Chief's resolution, and have a cheque issue in Mr. Rep's favour for \$8³³ being balance due him for the ~~past~~ month of January, and hereafter his monthly cheque will be increased to \$41⁶⁶ per month.
