5. (a) Courses

(1) Courses will be conducted at A7 Cdn Army Adm School, beginning 8 Aug, as follows:

Ninth Adm Wing - 52 Offrs and 10 GWAC Offrs Ninth QM Wing - 14 QMs and 25 QMSs Ninth Clerical Wing = 33 candidates.

(ii) DND courses, beginning 2 Aug, will be conducted as follows:

(111) 10 offrs will attend the twelfth Army Air Sp Course at Debert, beginning 2 Aug.

Recruits chosen for the CAC, C Inf C and RCAMC will proceed from Depots to Basic TCs which are linked to specific Corps TCs. Recruits for other Corps will proceed direct from Depots to Corps TCs. Previously, all recruits went from the Depots to the most conveniently situated Basic TCs and after completing eight-weeks' basic trg, they were allocated to Corps TCs.
