No. 79. Your telegram No. 51. No action of any kind will be taken by us in the Netherlands and Belgium until we have consulted you further. Should like to add that circular letter was sent Friday to British subjects in the Netherlands by British Consul General inviting them to consider the advisability of taking necessary steps to remove elsewhere and asking them whether they wish to leave independently or be evacuated or remain under all circumstances. French nationals in Holland were also advised in the same sense.
