

shall be entered in the journal; and, at the next regular session, should two-thirds of those present be in favor thereof, the same shall be adopted and have full force as parts of these laws.

SEC. 2. This Encampment has power to adopt such rules of order as a majority shall concur in at a regular session, after having been proposed in writing at a previous session; and, to amend, alter or annul the same in like manner. But a motion to suspend a rule of order for a particular occasion may be adopted at any time by a vote of two-thirds of the members present.
