### HISTORY OF STANLEY CUP (Continued)

10-6; 2 out of three games. Montreal A.A.A. (Little Men of Iron) defeat Winnipeg Victorias, March, 22-3. 1903—Ottawa Hockey Club, as champions of C.A.H.L., take cup. Ottawa Hockey Club defeat Rat Portage, March, 10-4, two out of three games.

1904—Ottawa Hockey Club defeat Winnipeg Rowing Club, January, 13-7, two out of three games. Ottawa Hockey Club defeat Toronto Marlboros, Feb., 17-5, two out of three games. Ottawa Hockey Club defeat Brandon, March, 15-6; two out of three games. 1905—Ottawa defeated Yukon, 32-4; two out of three games. Ottawa defeated Rat Portage, 15-12; two out of three. 1906 Eastern Canada Hockey Association formed with same membership as Senior C.A.H.L. cup series, games to be decided by majority of goals in two matches. Ottawa defended the cup against Queen's University, and Smith's Falls. Montreal Wanderers, champions E.C.H.L., take cup. 1907—(Rat Portage) Kenora defeat Wanderers, Wanderers defeat Kenora. 1908—Montreal Wanderers defeat Ottawa Victorias; Wanderers defeat Winnipeg Maple Leafs; Wanderers defeat Toronto. 1909—Ottawa, champions E.C.H.A. take cup. 1910—Ottawa defeat Galt, Edmonton, Wanderers take cup. Wanderers defeat Berlin. 1911—Ottawa as champions of National Hockey Association again take possession. 1912—Quebec won the National Hockey Association championship and defeated New Glasgow for the Stanley Cup in two straight games. 1913—No Stanley cup games—1914—Toronto won the National Hockey Association championship and defeated Victoria at Toronto in world's series at Toronto for the Cup. 1915—Ottawa won the National Hockey Association Championship and lost to Vancouver at the Coast. 1916—Canadiens won N. H. A. Championship and defeated Portland in four out of seven games for the World's Championship. 1917—Canadiens defeated by Seattle at the Coast—1918—Toronto won N. H. A. and defeated Vancouver for the Cup. 1919—Canadiens won championship N. H. L. and World's Series ended with team even.

1920—Ottawa wins National League and tonight's game is one of three out of five which will decide the Championship of the world and the winners will hold the Stanley Cup. Ottawa went through the National League by winning both sections and Seattle won the Western Section over the home and home route.

This season's games have the additional interest of being International, United States vs. Canada.
