VICTORIÆ REGINÆ.

CAP. I.

An Act to enable County Councils to raise money for assisting persons in certain cases to sow their land, and for other purposes.

[Assented to 5th May, 1863.]

THEREAS, from the failure last year of the crops in many Preamble. of the townships of Upper Canada, many persons will not be able to procure seed, without assistance, and it is expedient to empower County Councils to raise money for their relief: Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

1. Not withstanding any law in force in Upper Canada, the County Coun-Council of any County may pass a By-law, or By-laws, for cils may raise raising money, not exceeding in the whole twenty thousand buying seed, dollars, to be expended in the purchase of seed, and for the &c. relief of persons suffering from the failure of the crops, and for no other purpose; and the debentures issued under such Bylaws shall be a charge on the County.

2. Such By-law shall be in the form of Schedule A to this Form of By-Act, and the sections numbered two hundred and twenty-two, law. two hundred and twenty-three, two hundred and twenty-four Certain proviand two hundred and twenty-five of the Act respecting the sions not to apply. Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada, chapter fifty-four of the Consolidated Statutes for Upper Canada, shall not apply thereto.

3. The County Council shall lend the money so raised, in County to lend such sums as they may deem expedient, to Township Councils the Money to the Townships. requesting the same, and shall impose and levy a special rate. in each year, against the Municipality so borrowing, over and
