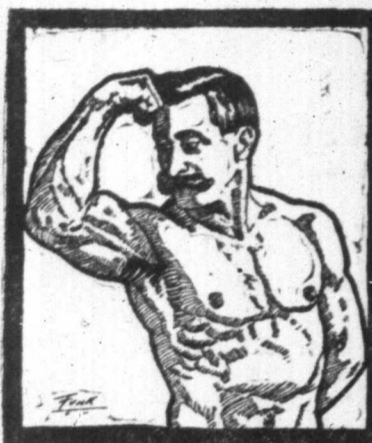

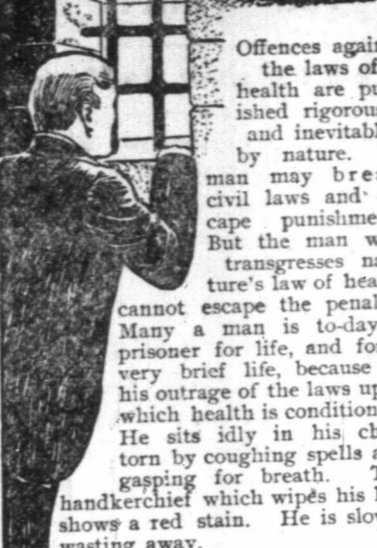
The Junior League of Park St. Church meets on Thursday at 4.30 p. m., and the Mission Band on Saturday at 3.30 p. m.

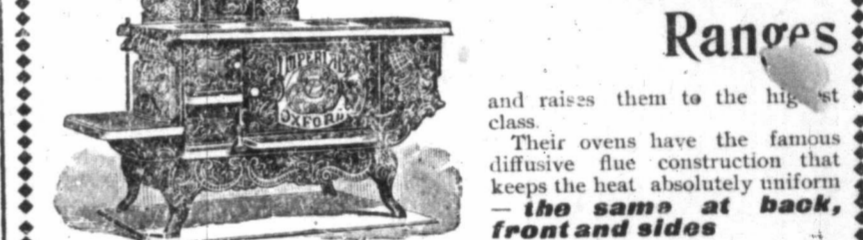
