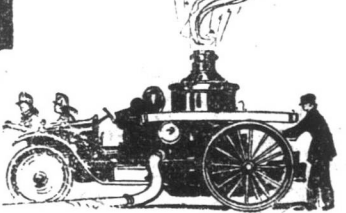

Notice to Milk Dealers.

The attention of farmers and milk-dealers is directed to the following sections of the Regulations respecting the Production and Sale of Milk:

1. No person shall sell, or offer or expose for sale within the District of St. John's, any milk or cream without having first obtained a license from the Medical Health Officer.
2. All licenses shall be for the period of one year, commencing on the first day of June in each year. Licenses shall be granted free of charge.
3. Any person who shall sell or offer or expose for sale in the District of St. John's any milk or cream without having first obtained a license in accordance with the provisions of these Regulations, shall be liable for every such offence to a penalty not exceeding twenty-five dollars or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding one month.

Licenses may be obtained at the Public Health Office, 268 Duckworth Street.

Mate of Windjammer Puts in Stirring Year

Seattle, Wash., June 9. (A.P.)—Mutiny on the high seas, typhoons, and Chinese pirates were among the experiences which the last year allotted Fred N. Troup, first officer of the five-masted schooner "Teeng Tai" which, flying the flag of the Chinese republic, has been docked here loading lumber.

Troup, whose home is at Puyallup, Wash., near Seattle, signed last summer as first officer on the American schooner Levi W. Ostrander. When her name was changed to Teeng Tai and Chinese took over the vessel, Troup became master. On a voyage from Shanghai to Foochow, the schooner touched at the port of Quantow. While it was lying at anchor Chinese bandits appeared.

"The Danish chief mate and I were the only white men aboard," recalled Troup. "Each of us had an automatic. I fired 22 times. Some fell; I couldn't count how many. My Chinese crew of 28 were caught in their quarters and three were slain. We managed to get in a motor boat and escape." Later they regained their ship, which the pirates had deserted after removing everything portable.

The Teeng Tai was refitted and held under the Admiralty courts while salvage claims were contested. Under a new ownership Troup went to Puget Sound with her as second officer. On the way the crew mutinied, but the trouble was quelled and the men responsible for it put in irons to be delivered to the police at Vancouver, B.C.

World's Biggest Reservoir

Thousands of men and tons of human-like machinery are transforming an area nearly four times that of the British Empire Exhibition grounds into the largest storage reservoir of its kind in the world at Littleton, near Laleham, Middlesex.

The reservoir, one of the marvels of British engineering enterprises, has been rendered necessary by the ever-increasing population in the area served by the Metropolitan Water Board.

About 6,750,000,000 gallons of water will be stored in the reservoir which has a circumference of nearly four miles, and covers a water surface of about 723 acres. The raw river water from the Thames, after a "period" of storage in the new Littleton reservoir, will gravitate to the works at Kempton Park.

Magnificent pumping machinery to deal with the filtered water will be erected at Kempton Park. The maximum pumping capacity of the engines will be 16,000,000 gallons of water each 24 hours against a head of 300 feet.

More than 2,000 men are employed on the works to-day. There are 22 miles of railway track, 20 locomotives, and about 400 wagons, trucks, and other rolling plant. The coal consumption for the various operations amounts to about 150 tons weekly.

On the site of the new reservoir stood the major portion of the old village of Littleton, with its 1,200-year-old manor, which has now, with other buildings being submerged under 30 feet of water.

Gliders From the Sky

DESCENTS FROM AERIAL LINERS.

Motorless sky tenders are to be used on the great Eastern Railway between Berlin and Tokyo for the use of passengers desiring to alight at any of the intermediate "halts" which are to be established along the route at suitable intervals.

When the place at which the descent is to be made is approached the travellers will take their places in the tender slung on special tackle beneath the cabin of the sky-liner.

The giant parent aeroplane will descend to a suitable height from the altitude at which it will normally fly, and the speed, which on the average will be about 150 miles an hour, will be reduced to one at which the tender can be safely launched.

Warned By Wireless.

The releasing lever will then be pulled, and the passengers in the tender will find themselves drifting gently eastward to the landing-ground below, the staff of which will have been informed by wireless from the air-liner that a descent is to be made to set down passengers.

This method has been adopted in order to save time, as it is intended, by flying at night as well as during the day, to bring Japan within three days journey of Berlin. Already the airway between Berlin and Moscow has been flown over successfully, and steps are being taken to establish a long chain of lights for the guidance of pilots travelling at night.

When the service is established it will be possible, in conjunction with the airline that links up Croydon with Berlin, to reach Tokyo in about four days.
