Permission has now been received from my Government for all persons residing in the interior and coastal sections of Newfoundland, except on the Avalon Peninsula, when proceeding to the United States by rail and via Port aux Basques, to obtain passport and immigration visas at the American Consulate at Sydney, Nova Scotia. This privilege does not apply to any other American Consulate in Canada, and all persons who intend to avail themselves thereby, when proceeding to Sydney must first write to the American Consulate at St. John's and obtain written authority, visas form to be filled in prior to departure, and other instructions. All such persons are warned that they are liable to be refused visas by the American Consul at Sydney if they do not comply fully with the above preliminaries.


