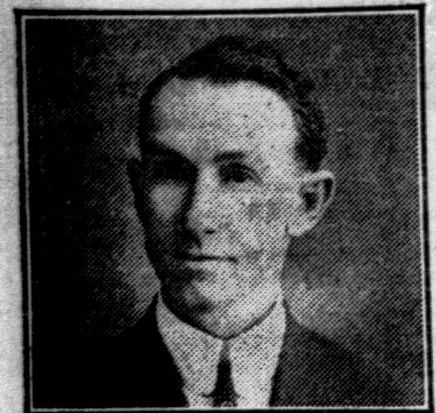

GERMANY BLAMES EXPLOSIVE CARGO

Say Lusitania Was Hit Once, and That
She Showed No Flag.

BERLIN, May 14, via Amsterdam to London, May 15.—3:07 a.m.—From the report received from the submarine which sank the Cunard S. S. Line steamer Lusitania yesterday, the following official version of the incident is published by the admiralty staff under the signature of Admiral Behncke: "The submarine sighted the steamer, which showed no flag, May 7 at 2:20 o'clock, central European time, after noon on the southeast coast of Ireland in fine, clear weather."
"At 2:19 o'clock one torpedo was fired at the Lusitania, which hit her starboard side below the captain's bridge. The detonation of the torpedo was followed immediately by a further explosion of extremely strong effect. The ship quickly listed to starboard and began to sink."

"The second explosion must be traced back to the ignition of quantities of ammunition inside the ship."

SHOULD MURDER MAY BE CLEARED

Detective, Following, Clue in
Woodstock, Feels Confi-
dent of Success.

WOODSTOCK, May 14.—Emerson B. Shelly, claiming Simcoe as his home, was today sentenced by Judge Wallace to two years in Kingston Penitentiary for a serious crime against a child named Snell, who lives in Newark, near Norwich, where Shelly was recently employed as a farm laborer.

Arrested in this city Wednesday evening through the keen instincts of Constable Samuel Bickley, Shelly then admitted his identity as the man wanted by the Norwich authorities, and today he refused the aid of legal counsel, pleaded guilty and threw himself on the mercy of the court.

Interviewed by Inspector. As soon as Shelly was returned to the jail, Provincial Inspector John Miller, aided by Chief of Police Killings, questioned the convicted man in connection with the death of Christopher Shoup, a wealthy farmer and miller of Norfolk County, who was shot and killed at 3 o'clock Tuesday afternoon, while plowing near his residence.

When the body was discovered some time later, it was found that he had met his death through a revolver bullet which pierced the carotid artery and tore his throat to pieces, killing him instantly.

On Parole From Kingston. Shelly, who was recently released from Kingston Penitentiary, where he served sixteen months, and who was on parole to return regularly to the Simcoe police, is said to have been drinking in that town shortly before the murder. It is suspected that he had knowledge of Shoup's habits of carrying sums of money on his person.

It is reported that Shelly recently exhibited a loaded revolver, but no weapon was in his possession when he was arrested here.

He was questioned about this by the local police and the Inspector. He reached Woodstock on Wednesday forenoon. The murder occurred about 35 miles from here about 11 o'clock Wednesday morning.

GERMANS GIVE UP BY HUNDREDS TO POLICE OF ENGLAND

Object to Repatriation, Saying Britain
Is Home—Prefer Internment.

LONDON, May 14.—11:25 p.m.—The police throughout the country have been busy all day gathering subjects of hostile countries of military age and dispatching them to concentration camps.

Many hundreds voluntarily surrendered and were sent off in batches of 500 going to Southend, to be placed aboard steamers which have been fitted up for the purpose. The only difficulty the authorities are faced with is that of finding the men, as the suddenness with which the Government came to its decision, following the riots, gave no time to prepare any camps.

As all subjects of enemy countries have been registered since the commencement of the war and have been compelled to report periodically to the police, there is no difficulty in locating them. Some, however, with large businesses must be given time to arrange their affairs. In most cases the business has been transferred to Britishers or neutrals, but some alien businessmen closed their premises. One result of this was felt in the east end of London, where the majority of the small bakers are Germans, the people this morning finding themselves deprived of their usual supplies.

A greater task will be that of arranging for the repatriation of women and children, and men over military age. Many of the latter have resided in England a lifetime, and have no other home, and are pleading as an alternative to be interned with the younger men. Although the country has been calmed by the Government decision to deal with aliens, considerable sporadic anti-German rioting occurred in some parts of London to night, Peckham, Nunhead and Tottenham among them, a number of German shops were attacked.

Serious disturbances also are reported from Rotherham and North Shields among other places.

By night the streets were crowded with carrying away provisions of all kinds from the looted shops. At North Shields many shops were attacked, but there was no looting.

London Hopes U.S. Will Not Get Into War

High Officials Think Diplo-
matic Relations Will
Be Severed.

LONDON, May 14.—The firm attitude which the American Government has taken with regard to Germany's submarine action against her ships and citizens meet with general approval, and the question now is not "what the United States will do," but "what Germany's answer will be."

It is believed in high official circles here that Germany will not agree to reverse her submarine blockade policy, and the conclusion is drawn that the United States will be compelled to sever diplomatic relations with her. The hope is everywhere expressed that the United States will not be drawn into war as it is considered by observers of the situation that she is the greater assist to Germany as a neutral than she would be as a belligerent.

PORTUGAL IN THROES OF INTERNAL TROUBLE

News Dispatches Tell of Grave
Revolutionary Movement
Against Republicans.

LONDON, May 15.—12:45 p.m.—A news agency dispatch received here from Madrid declares there has been received in the Spanish capital information of a grave revolutionary movement in Portugal. One report is to the effect that a revolutionary committee is in control of the situation at Lisbon.
