INVESTMENTS IN ISLAND TIMBER

Michigan Capitalist Is Seeking To Secure Further Limits—Has Now Many Large Interests Here

The acquisition of British Columbia timber lands by American capitalists goes on apace. Wm. F. McKnight, a prominent operator of Grand Rapids, Mich., accompanied by Col. Catrow, of Dayton, Ohio, reached the coast yester- day to investigate a number of tim- ber tracts. This is the colonel's first visit to the coast. He is a man of means and represents large Ohio banking interests. His quest is successful several million dollars will be invested on Vancouver Island and the mainland during the next few months.

Mr. McKnight is already heavily in- terested on Vancouver Island. Last year he was the moving spirit in or- ganizing a syndicate which acquired vast timber holdings in the Jordan river district on the West coast of the island. The limits were about 100,000 acres. Mr. McKnight is secretary of the company.

Since his last visit here several months ago, Mr. McKnight, in con- junction with Michigan, Chicago and Salt Lake capitalists, organized the New Miami Lumber company, with a paid up capital of \$500,000. This corporation, of which Mr. McKnight is president, has acquired a hundred million feet of timber in the Jordan River district. The company has not elaborated its plans, but in all probability a big timber tract will be secured next year. Meantime, the company intends to engage in logging operations.

There will be a great deal of American capital invested in British Columbia timber limits this year. The leading operators have already made a start and their example is to be followed by others. Although the market is light in the eastern and middle states, the demand is not exceptionally good, but it looks for a more active trade shortly in harmony with the activity in other industries," said Mr. McKnight. Mr. McKnight also has a large share in the purchase of the Vancouver Island limits of Messrs. Sayward & Co. The properties have been turned over to a new corporation styled the Michi- gan, Puget Sound Lumber company, with a capitalization of \$1,250,000. The mill plant is to be enlarged.

PREMIER PROPOSES THAT INQUIRY COMMITTEE SHALL HAVE POWER TO INQUIRE INTO ONE PART OF SUBJECT

Mr. Lennox Cites Figures Showing Vast Difference Between the Estimates and Actual Returns

OTTAWA, Jan. 25.—The first en- gagement of the cabinet over the charges of over-classification of the National Transcontinental, arising out of the resignation of Hugh D. Lumsden as chief engineer, was fought to- day. The matter came up on the motion of Sir Wilfrid Laurier calling for a special committee of five mem- bers to investigate the charges made against a portion of his engineering staff by Mr. Lumsden in his letter of resignation to the commission. When appointed to the committee the question of over-classification was now had in under advisement. Sir Wilfrid Laurier declared that the com- mittee would confine its energies to investigating the truth or falsity of Mr. Lumsden's charges that some of his staff had not carried out his in- structions.

This called down some opposition criticism. Mr. Lennox went into the question of over-classification, show- ing that the whole of the eastern sec- tion seemed to have a maximum amount of rock cutting and a mini- mum of common earth excavation. He moved an amendment calling for a committee of seven with power broad- ened to investigate all the charges made by Mr. Lumsden.

This was opposed by Mr. Graham, who longly went into the history of the contract and classification arbi- tration, the debate being continued by Mr. Barker and E. Macdonald. The matter will come up again on Thursday, when a division is expected.

AWFUL HARDSHIP FOR POOR PEOPLE

Floods in France Grow Worse, and Hundreds of Thousands Are Driven From Homes—Damage Incalculable.

PARIS, Jan. 25.—The floods have brought disaster to a large part of France. The ordinarily modest and peaceful Seine is now a raging torrent, and rising at the rate of over half an inch an hour. The general opinion is that the maximum of the flood will be reached tonight and will be realized. Officials report this afternoon that the Seine's affluents were beginning to fall, but the river itself is still rising steadily, and the official estimate tonight is that the river will be at least fifteen inches higher by tomorrow morn- ing.

The victims of the flood number more than a hundred thousand, and the money loss is incalculable. Thousands of poor people are hopelessly ruined, and are fleeing for Paris. The government has ordered the navy material to be used for the rescue of the stricken, as well as those of the inhabitants to evacuate their homes. Hundreds of them refused to leave, claiming only for food and water. In Paris the situation is rapidly becoming worse, the floods sparing neither rich nor poor. The flood is invading the public buildings and forcing the evacuation of many houses. The streets in one arondissement in the southeastern portion are running rivers. The subway and train services are dimi- nishing, and in every section gas and electric lights are falling. Part is practically cut off south and west, and the question of food supplies will become a serious one. The hospital at Ivry, containing 2,000 patients, is surrounded by water. As there is no means of cooking the food or of heating the building, the patients must be removed unless the flood subsides, and the attending physicians fear that grave results will follow.

President Fallieres and Premier Briand made an auto trip this afternoon through some of the streets, knee deep with mud and water, and saw the crowds of freezing men tugging at loads of valuables and weeping women bur- dened with children and household be- longings.

SECOND COMET

Unexpected Celestial Visitor Viewed From Northern Points and From Ottawa.

HAZELTON, Jan. 25.—A comet of great magnitude and brilliancy has been visible since the evening of the 24th from Dawson to Ashcroft, and at all intermediate stations along the Yukon telegraph. It was visible at 5:30 this evening directly after sunset. It was then situated about 36 degrees south of west and near the horizon. It now has the appearance of a large star. The tail is wide and reaches two-thirds of the distance from the zenith to the horizon, and has a decided curve. Its nucleus dis- appeared below the horizon at 7:45, but the tail was plainly visible for two hours afterwards.

Battered by Gales

SAN FRANCISCO, Jan. 25.—Batter- ed by 17 days of a terrific gale, the little schooner A. B. Johnson arrived here today from Grays Harbor. Two days out from that port, January 12, the schooner encountered a typhoon of an hour gale which lasted until she was near this port, 15 days later. Although her superstructure suffered from the heavy seas which swept over her she is not badly damaged. Pretty far everything movable on her decks was smashed.

Engineers in Convention

OTTAWA, Jan. 25.—The afternoon session of the Canadian society of civil engineers was partly devoted to a discussion of the actual cost of haulage in railway and waterway transportation, as opposed to some of the tariffs charged. It was held that the railroads did not know anything for all it would stand. The committee will make a thorough investigation of the cost of carriage over different Canadian sections and the cost per general public how freight tariffs could be lowered.
