### GREAT EXPLOSION OF POWDER

Gijon, Spain, Feb. 26.—Upwards of 200 people were killed or wounded by the ill timed explosion of a charge of 7,000 pounds of black powder, which had been laid yesterday by the engineers in charge of the new harbor works with the object of razing an enormous block of rock.

An immense concourse of townspeople had gathered to witness the demolition of the hill separating Gijon from the coal harbor of Musel, a mile and a half distant.

When the explosion occurred, instead of the rock being blasted, hundreds of tons of clay and small stones were hurled like artillery projectiles among the assembled spectators. Whole families were mowed down as well as many of the engineers and municipal officials. Twenty-four bodies have been recovered, but it is considered certain that the fatalities will far exceed this number.

### MOUNT ALLISON'S PRESSING NEED

The Campaign Committee of Mount Allison University at Sackville have secured the services R. A. Cassidy of New York in the forward movement planned for next month. Mr. Cassidy has had wide experience in work of this nature and is said to be an organizer of exceptional ability. The details of the campaign have not yet been fully worked out, but plans are now being arranged by means of which it is hoped to clearly place the need of the Sackville, institutions before every graduate and other friend of the college in Canada.

Mount Allison requires a new science building, and it is felt that fifty thousand dollars set apart for this purpose, from the quarter million which the committee hope to raise, will give the institution an equipment of science equal to any in the eastern provinces, and sufficient for many years to come. This, however, is not a first consideration in the coming campaign. Mount Allison's most pressing need is a sufficient regular annual income to entirely eliminate all possibility of further deficits and to guarantee that for the future the university will be self-supporting in so far as this term may be applied to a denominational institution, and with this end in view, the first efforts of the committee will be directed to securing two hundred thousand dollars as an addition to the permanent endowment, and only after this has been obtained will the proposed new science building be given consideration. The annual deficit on operation has averaged three thousand dollars for some years, so it will be seen that with eight thousand or ten thousand additional income, the university should be able to get along very comfortably.

### MORE LOCOMOTIVES FOR INTERCOLONIAL

Moncton, N. B. March 3rd, 1913.

The continued increase of passenger and freight traffic on the Intercolonial Railway has been the cause for some very large orders for additional motive power. In addition to the nineteen locomotives ordered recently, additional orders have been placed for twenty nine more, twenty of which are to be of the heavy freight type, four large passenger engines, and four for switching purposes. During the past eight months motive power to amount of \$3,600,000 has been ordered, and \$2,000,000 of this is to be paid out of revenue. Several of the engines ordered some time ago have already been delivered and the full complements of the order is expected by September. Every effort is being made to meet the demands the steadily growing traffic.

### EXPORT BUSINESS GROWS AT PORTLAND

Portland, Me., March 1.—Some idea of the extent of the export business from this port this year can be gained by considering a few statistics. Up to Saturday morning the grain, mostly wheat, shipments, had reached 5,737,332 bushels and the shipments for the balance of the season exclusive of the sailings Saturday, will, it is expected, reach 3,000,000 bushels more, and the shipments for Saturday amounted to about 500,000 bushels.

The other lines of exports will make this a great season and as far as can be now seen a record breaker. Portland will be one of the great export cities of the country this year, and will be a close rival even to the largest in the extent of the wheat shipments, and will easily be so when it comes to the emigrant passenger service.
