Nasawan.	The breathing.
Msinasawôgan. ¹	A sigh.
Kôgôlwawôgan.	A cry ; a scream.
Nakwhômowôgan.	Sneezing.
Chachapsolowôgon.	The hiccough, hiccup.
Nolmukwsowôgan.	Drowsiness.
Chigualakwsowôgan.	Snoring.
Leguasowôgan.	A dream.
Lalômowôgan.	The voice.
Kelozowôgan.	Speech.

1. In general, by suppressing the two syllables *wô-gan* from the substantives having that termination, as above, we have the indicat. pres. 3d pers. sing. of a verb ; as thus : *msinasa*, he (she) sighs ; *kôgôlwa*, he (she) cries ; *akuamalso*, he (she) is sick.
