into his possession the person of the king; but in doing this a crowd assembled, and the brave commander fell by a clab, after which he was dispatched by a dagger; and his body was carried off in triumph and devoured. This melancholy event occurred in the morning of the 14th February, 1779. Captain Cook left a widow and family; on the former a pension of 200% a year was settled by the king, and 25% a year on each of the children.
