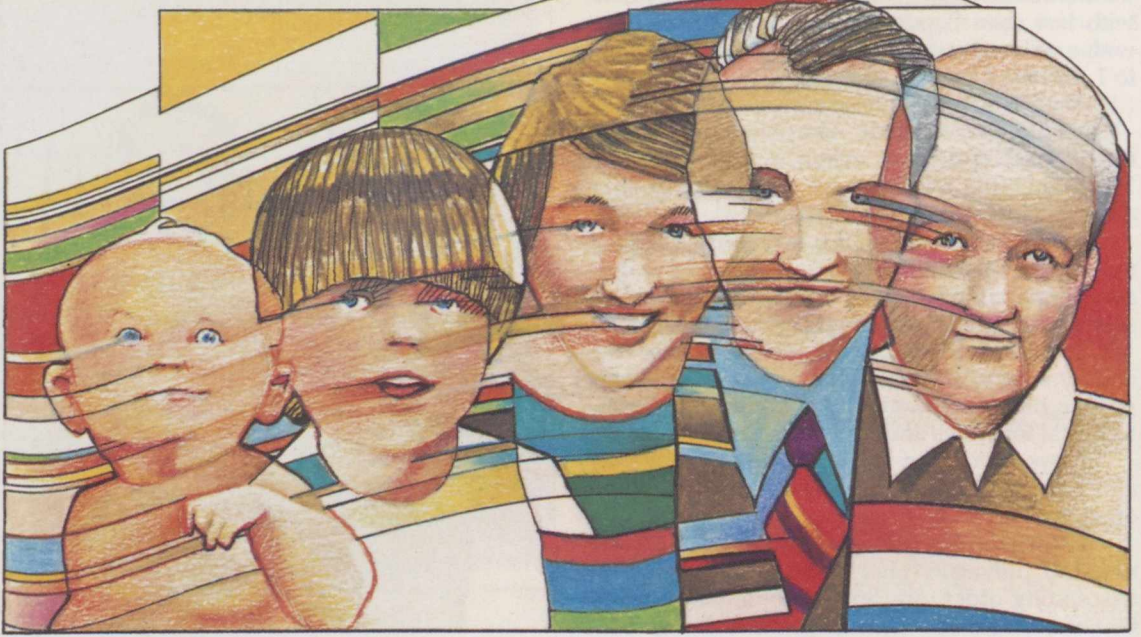


CHANGING NEEDS
