On behalf of Mr. Mark Malloch Brown, Administrator of UNDP, I am pleased to present to you the following statement:

The world community agreed at Rio that climate change objectives, poverty eradication and sustainable development can and must be harmonised, and supported by sustained capacity building. While progress is being made in reconciling these objectives, much remains to be done.

The solution to these enormous challenges hinges on improved governance and on participatory decision making processes that involve all segments of society. This must include better, more targeted sustainable energy, forestry, and economic policies, institutional mechanisms and capacity-building programmes. UNDP sees its comparative advantage--articulated in Agenda 21-- as building the necessary capacities for, by and in developing countries so that they can meet their sustainable development objectives while at the same time contributing to climate change mitigation.
