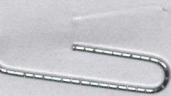


Ministerial Meeting of the East European Countries, Bangkok

February 14, 1990



1. The meeting was held in Bangkok, Thailand, on February 14, 1990, at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Bangkok. The meeting was attended by the Ministers of Foreign Affairs of the following countries: Bulgaria, Czech Republic, Hungary, Poland, Romania, Slovakia, and the former Yugoslavia (Serbia, Croatia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, and Slovenia). The meeting was chaired by the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Czech Republic, Mr. Petr Pithulak. The agenda of the meeting included: (a) Opening remarks by the Chairman; (b) Report on the work of the Committee of Experts on the Balkans; (c) Discussion of the situation in the Balkans; (d) Adoption of the Declaration on the Balkans; (e) Closing remarks by the Chairman.
