- Mr. Gérard Loiselle (Parliamentary Secretary to Minister of Transport): 1. No ships are being retired directly as a result of the Department of Transport budget reduction. The following ships were due to be retired following many months of analysis and operations research which showed that Coast Guard activities could be conducted satisfactorily without them and the budget reduction has accelerated this process slightly. CCGS Gannet, CCGS Edward Cornwallis, CCGS C. D. Howe, CCGS Auk, CCGS Estevan, CCGS Mink, CCGS Marmot, CCGS Lurcher, and the CCGS C. P. Edwards.
