Which said Address being read by the Clerk was unanimously agreed to.

Ordered, That the said Address be engrossed and that the same be signed by the

Honorable the Speaker.

Ordered, that the said Address be presented to His Excellency the Governor General by those Members of this House who are Members of the Privy Council.

Then on motion of the Honorable Mr. Hamilton (Kingston), seconded by the Honorable Mr. Campbell, the House adjourned.
