1st. Its situation, and length in miles.

2nd. The amount expended in surveying and locating it, distinguishing between the expenditure previous, and subsequent to the appointment of the Commissioners.

3rd. The date of the contract and the gross amount to be paid for the

construction.

4th. The amount paid to the Contractors for work done up to this date; and the estimated value of work done but not paid for.

5th. The number of men and teams employed at the present time; and when none are employed, the date at which work was suspended.

6th. The names of the Engineers, Assistants, or other persons employed in superintending the work from its commencement to the present time, with the date of appointment and rate of salary. Also, a copy of the form of contract, and the specification or document containing the information furnished to contractors; to enable them to estimate the extent and value of the work to be tendered for; and to guide them in performing it. Also, the names of persons appointed as valuators and solicitors, with their salaries; and the amount paid or to be paid as far as ascertained in each county intersected by the line, for lands and improvements taken by the Railway Commissioners. Also, an account of all money expended on the line for explorations, surveys, or other purposes, from Mr. Fleming's appointment to the appointment of the Commissioners; and copies of all amounts of expenditure and liabilities furnished by the Commissioners to the Receiver General, from the date of their appointment up to the present time; as required by the 24th Section of "An Act respecting the construction of the Intercolonial "Railway."
