Our Cancer Commission has not yet completed its investigation and presented its report. I hope that this will be ready in a month or so. When it is published, I shall be glad to send you a copy.

The question you ask about the use of the donation for direct research or for the clinic is hard to answer. My opinion would be that through the development of the Cancer Clinic, you would most helpfully stimulate Cancer Research. The clinical <sup>work</sup> and the research work are closely linked. If you began by enlarging your Clinics you would probably find that some one in the staff would have an idea which he wished to develop - then your Research work begins successfully at once.
