Portuguese Minhag. Synagogue on the Jew Savanah, situated on the Surinam River.

2. K. K. TSEDEK VESHALOME. צדק ושלום

Portuguese Minhag. Synagogue fronting Graave street, in the City of Paramaribo.

3. K. K. NEVEH SHALOME. נוח שלום

New Synagogue fronting Keyzer street, in the City of Paramaribo, was built on the old site and consecrated, Nissan 30, 5597—May 5, 1837. The three Burial places of the two latter congregations are on the Graave street, above the Viotti bridge, on the road to Quatta. Earliest organization in 1664.
