2. For alterations in the present building. to make apartments now occupied by the Principal into dormituries to accommodate more pupils.
3. For repairs on the present building and additional rooms for the teaching staff.

## REMOVAL OF DEFICITS, $\$ 60,000$

The increasing cost of exchange and operation has resulted in a deficit of nearly $\$ 50,000$ in the Foreign Mission Fund. Owing to heavier demands on their resources, the Aged and Infirm ${ }^{\text {A }}$ 'inisters ${ }^{\prime}$ Fund and the Pointe-aux-Trembles Schools also showed deficits in 1918. For the removal of these $\$ 60,000$ is set down in the special offering.

## TO ASSURE ADEQUATE CURRENT REVENUE, $\$ 100,000$

$\$ 100,000$ is to be set apart for current revenue, to help assure adequate maintenance of the work during the next two years. At the same time it is earnestly hoped that every session and congregation will see to it that during the special effort the Annual Budget is generously maintained and advanced.

The $\$ 4,000,000$ apportioned as above, represents the shart of the Presbyterian Church in the Great National Thank Offering of $\$ 12,000$,000 to be presented by the five co-operating communions (viz. Anglican, Baptist, Congregational, Methucist and Presbyterian) curing the second week in February, 1920.
