XXIII.-DUTIES OF AUDITORS.

There shall be three or more Auditors of the Society, to be elected at the general annual meeting, who shall be eligible for re-election; they shall andit the accounts of the Society, and see that they are correctly kept; and shall lay before each quarterly meeting a balance sheet of the receipts and expenditure, and also of the assets and liabilities of the Society, signed by them with a statement of the Society's affairs since the last quarterly meeting, and of its then condition. The Auditors shall have power to call for and examine all papers and documents belonging to the Society.

XXIV.-WITHDRAWAL OF MEMBERS.

Any member wishing to withdraw from the Society may do so by transferring all his shares as provided for in
