#### WILSON SENDS PLEDGE OF AID FOR RUSSIANS

United States Will Help to Drive Out Autocracy.  
TO RESTORE COUNTRY  
President Promises Full Rehabilitation—Hopes Still for Uprising.

#### Wilson's Message to Russia

"May I not take advantage of the meeting of the congress of the soviet to express the sincere sympathy which the people of the United States feel for the Russian people at this moment, when the German power has been thrust in to interrupt and turn back the whole struggle for freedom and substitute the wishes of Germany for the purpose of the people of Russia. Altho the government of the United States is, unhappily, not now in a position to render the direct and effective aid it would wish to render, I beg to assure the people of Russia, thru the congress, that it will avail itself of every opportunity to secure for Russia once more complete sovereignty and independence in her own affairs and full restoration to her great role in the life of Europe and the modern world. The whole heart of the people of the United States is with the people of Russia in the attempt to free themselves forever from autocratic government and become the masters of their own life. (Signed) "Woodrow Wilson."



#### TOTAL SOLDIERS' VOTE.

London, March 11.—The number of soldiers' voting papers counted in England was 45,128. Rejected by the returning officer were 4182. Rejected by mutual consent of the scrutineers 19,984. Total vote, 101,371.

#### Intoxicating Liquor, However, May Be Manufactured for Various Purposes.

Ottawa, March 11.—Canada virtually goes dry on April 1. Under regulations issued tonight, the manufacture of intoxicating liquors is prohibited from that date. It is provided, however, that "in case of sale of intoxicating liquor of any class for beverage purposes is permitted in any province, this regulation shall not apply to the manufacture of such intoxicating liquor in such province until Dec. 31, 1918." The latter provision, in regard to manufacture, is operative in two cases:
