

CHARACTERISTICS OF THE BOERS.

Their Past Conflicts With the British-The Great Moving -Unexcelled Marksmen and Puritanical in Their Piety.

Two hundred and forty-nine years ago Holland was pushing her enterprises with great energy in two countries that were very widely different. One colony was established on the Island of Manhattan, at the mouth of the great river named for Hendrick Hudson, in North America. The other colony was planned by Mynheer Van Riebeck, at a point in South Africa called the Cape of Good Hope. Both grew apace and prospered. The irrepressible Anglo-Saxon took both of these away from Holland, as soon as they began to be developed and became profitable. It was in 1796 that, having bost her American colonies south of the St. Lawrence, England saw a peaceful, typical Dutch country which she coveted. It was what is now called Cape Colony, at the Cape of Good Hope, the capital being Cape Town. The South African Boer, or farmer, always hated his restless Anglo-Saxon conqueror, and was greatly gratified when his colony came again under Netherlandish or Holland rule, in 1803, at the peace of Amlens. But in 1806 England took it away from weak Holland. The Boers made the best fight they could, but had to
