Short Covering at Chicago Closes Wheat Market Higher

Better Export Inquiry in Spring Wheat Market—Winnipeg Stronger—Liverpool Cables Steady.

World Office. Tuesday Evening, Oct. 5.—Liverpool wheat futures closed unchanged from yesterday; corn 3/4 higher; oats 1/4 higher.

Chicago Dec. wheat closed today 1 1/2 higher; Dec. corn 3/4 higher, and Dec. Chicago car lots today: Wheat 70c higher; Dec. corn 1/2 cent higher, and Dec. 27; contract 70c.

Winnipeg car lots of wheat today 72c; this year last year 64c; oats 57c; barley 31c; northwest car lots of wheat today 104c; this year last year 96c.

Bradstreet's estimate of visible supply: Increase, wheat 1,265,000; corn, 700,000; oats, 1,000,000. European visible this week amounts to 7,000,000 bushels against 6,800,000 bushels last week, thus showing an increase of 200,000 bushels. Last year there was an increase of 4,800,000 bushels, when the total amounted to 65,700,000 bushels.

EXPORT CATTLE SELL HIGH

There were 37 carloads of fresh stock, consisting of 546 cattle, 48 hogs, 204 sheep and lambs, and 2 calves, for sale besides the export cattle left over from Monday's market. The total receipts for the two days were 84 carloads, 1284 cattle, 50 hogs, 107 sheep and lambs and 2 calves.

The quality of fat cattle, as a rule, was not up to the standard of this market, although there were a few good loads that brought high prices.

Trade was good all round for every-thing offered, one of the best markets of the year all being cleaned up by the noon hour.
