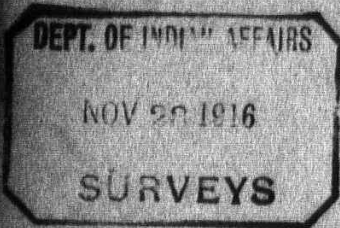

RE: Town of The Pas vs. C. N. R.

A dispute is going on between the above at the present time as to who is prior in the matter of Railway crossings through the Town of The Pas. I am desirous of obtaining the information as to when the plans of the Railway Company's line were filed, and whether the said Railway Company has complied with the provisions of the Railway Act regarding registering their plans. I have written the Land Titles Office to furnish me with a Search Letter or Certificate giving the date of registration, etc., but the Land Titles Office, Neepawa, advise me that no plan is registered, and that they only have in their office a Blue print which was sent to the said District Registrar at his request by the surveyor of the C. N. R. The District Registrar has referred me to you for plans, and to see if registration has been complied with. I shall be glad if you could furnish me with a plan and also inform me if the said
