

THEY SCORE SHORE LINE.

N. B. Southern Railway Severely Criticised in the Legislature.

Fredericton, April 8.—It was the Shore Line's turn in the house yesterday, and in the course of debate some pretty sharp things were said about its management.

Therefore it is enacted by this house, that it would be greatly to the benefit of the maritime province, particularly of that portion of the country traversed by the said New Brunswick Southern Railway as well as of advantage to the L. C. R., that the Dominion government should acquire the said New Brunswick Southern Railway and operate the same as a part of the I. C. R. system; and be it further

Resolved, that a copy of this resolution, signed by the clerk of this house, be forwarded to the minister of railways and canals, and that a copy be sent also to the secretary of the state, with the request that the same be submitted to the governor general in council.

The service of this railway to the people, has been most unsatisfactory and is getting worse. It was the first of the year, only eleven trips were made, and the road also received a subsidy from the Dominion government, for carrying the mails and that also has been most unsatisfactory. I am informed that some lumbermen have been compelled to abandon their operations in consequence of being unable to bring their supplies over the road.

Many appeals have been made for a better service and the answer to these appeals usually is that the road does not pay, and that they are not warranted in keeping it open. I venture to affirm that if the road does not pay, it ought to be sold to the public.

Many people are averse to management of the railway, and the rates charged are complained of by many persons. The sleepers of the rails are small, and much worn, and the ends of small capacity. All these things are responsible for its unsatisfactory condition.

The line Manchester Importer left Manchester on March 26th for Halifax. The advice to the Purvis agency at Halifax, of the arrival of the liner was given at St. John's and do not mention any great damage sustained. There are now three Purvis agents, one at the Lunenburg, London City and Exchange.

Dominion Line Canada sailed yesterday for Halifax at 10:30 a.m. The liner was discharged at the wharf, the cargo being landed in two lots.
