## ANCIENT CAFE TO BE DEMOLISHED

Cafe Royal, Famous Bohemian Resort, Soon to Disappear.

London, Sept. 20.—(A. P., by mail).—The Cafe Royal, London's ancient and most famous Bohemian resort, soon is to disappear. It is planned to tear it down and erect in its place a modern building of luxurious appointments.

The announcement of demolition has brought forth a flood of letters protesting against such a plan, largely from literary and professional men and women and from artists, boxers, singers and diplomats.

For more than forty years the establishment has been the centre of the cosmopolitan life of the city. The international fame of the Cafe Royal brought a fortune to its owner, Daniel Nicolas De Nicol, who left more than \$5,000,000 when he died in 1897.

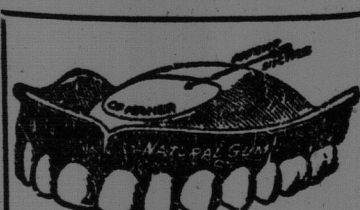

**NEW TESTS FOR PEARLS.**  
Ultraviolet Rays Said to Detect the Japanese Product.

Paris, Oct. 9.—The status of Japanese pearls as "fine pearls," which acquired last winter after French scientists reported to the government that there was no way of identifying them from the natural gem, is in danger. It has been discovered, Excelsior announces that ultraviolet rays will permit detection of the Japanese product. When submitted to the rays in a dark room the Japanese pearls give forth less fluorescence than natural ones.

Jewellers possessing valuable stocks of fine pearls have been fearful since the government's classification of the cultured product as genuine that they must lose large sums, as they could not expect a continued demand for their jewels when others recognized by science as being of equal value could be bought for half the price. ## MODERATION MOVE ON IN ALBERTA

Hotelmen's Association to Petition Under Direct Legislation Act for Measure to Allow Beer—May be Plebiscite.

Calgary, Oct. 9.—Alberta will probably have an opportunity of expressing an opinion on a new phase of the liquor act within the next two months.

It is said from the very best authority that the Alberta Hotelmen's Association has prepared a new act, now in the hands of the printer, entitled "The Alberta Temperance Act" under which it will be legal to sell real strength beer in hotel dining rooms, in clubs and on trains.

The hotelmen's association is taking steps to organize a petition under the direct legislation act, which means that the government has the option, when presented with a petition carrying the legal requirement of names, of passing the bill as it is presented to them, or giving a plebiscite within ninety days of the close of the next session.

**U. S. Ruling.**  
Washington, Oct. 9.—Foreign and U. S. vessels sailing for the United States after October 14 next will be subject to the prohibition against the bringing of intoxicating liquors into American territorial waters, it is announced at the treasury department.

Decision to defer in the case of these craft the enforcement of Attorney-General Daugherty's ruling with respect to the prohibition of the transportation of liquor cargoes or stores was made by President Harding.
