During that period 2,121 motor cars were imported from the United States to Canada, valued at \$2,474,462, while during the twelve months ended March, 31, 1910, only 1,457 machines were imported for by the fact that Canadian manufacturers have been exporting a considerable part of their output to India and Japan, thus getting a drawback upon the duty paid on material used in manufacture.

The customs figures show that the British manufacturers are not seriously competing in the Canadian market. During the last eight months only 134 automobiles valued at \$2,05,519 were imported from Great Britian.
