Jobbers and retailers report that stocks are moving rapidly and that shortages are developing in certain lines. Transportation difficulties are said to be responsible for this condition in many instances. Price changes have been comparatively few in number, and such as have occurred have been in the nature of advances. Word has been received that a number of manufacturers have notified jobbers of impending advances occasioned by the increase in the cost of materials. Jobbers are advising their trade to do their spring odreting early, and it is said that advance business has already reached large proportions."
