ECLIPSES.—In the Year 1859 there will be Four Eclipses of the Sun, and Two of the Moon.

1st—A Partial Eclipse of the Sun, Feb 2, 1859, invisible in Nova Scotia.

2d—A Total Eclipse of the Moon, February 17, 1859, partially visible in Nova Scotia; as the Moon will set before the Eclipse ends.

The first contact with the Shadow occurs at 121° from the Northernmost point of the Moon's limb towards the East. The last contact at 69° towards the West.

3d—A Partial Eclipse of the Sun, March 4, 1859, invisible in N. Scotia.

4th—A Partial Eclipse of the Sun, July 29, 1859, visible in Nova Scotia. Begins in Longitude 94° 13 E. of Greenwich, and Latitude 66° 26 N. at 4h. 12m. P. M. Mean Time at Halifax. Ends in Longitude 66° 43 W. of Greenwich, and Latitude 33° 39 N. at 7h. 11m.

5th—A Total Eclipse of the Moon, August 13, 1859, invisible in N. Scotia.

6th—A Partial Eclipse of the Sun, August 27, 1859, invisible in N. Scotia.
