PROSECUTING OFFICER'S CLOSING STATEMENT

Sir, In connection with the statement made by the defense I wish to point out that we have already established the fact that the accused's respirator was at the Field Punishment Camp during the time that the accused was in London. If the accused made an exchange of respirators at the Y.M.C.A., it rather appears as though he must have been in illegal possession of the respirator which he exchanged for exhibit "A".

FINDING: With reference to the third 'CHARGE' Not Guilty.

AFTER FINDING:

DEFENDING: Sir, on behalf of the accused I would like to give this evidence. I have been indirectly associated with the accused since practically the time of his enlistment, and that I have been his platoon commander and A/company Commander during his recruit training. During this period of time he has I might say he has been a victim of a mental condition toward Army Discipline, in that he has had a series of petty offences during his Recruit training and period with the Regiment, I therefore enter a plea of leniency on these grounds.
