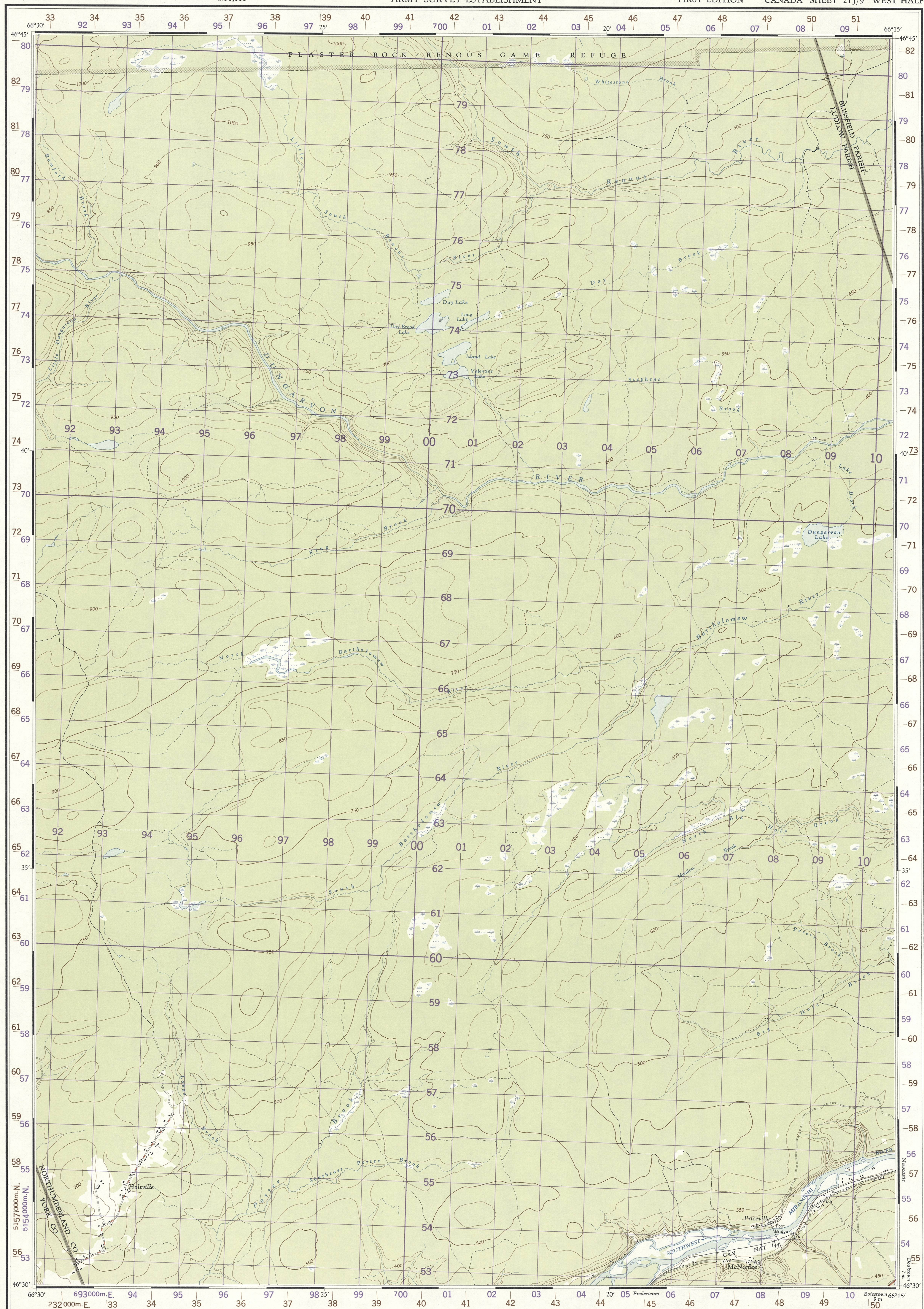
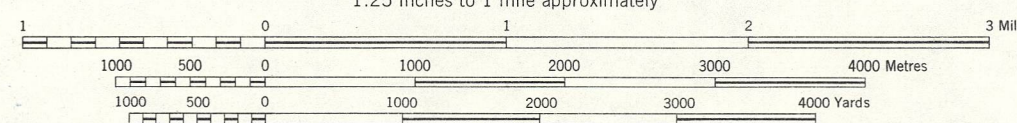

DOAKTOWN NEW BRUNSWICK

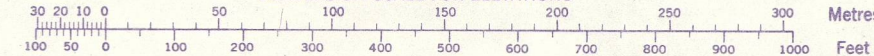
