ORGANIZE A RATTALION OF **DOCK WORKERS**

To prevent further delays 10,000 in battle with Govin handling of war supplies - Will wear khaki overalls.

Liverpool, March 31.—Lord Derby announced today that the government was planning to organize the dock workers of Liverpool, under the name of First Dock Battalion of the Liverpool Regiment. The men are to be dressed in khaki overails. This Lan is to be adopted to prevent further delays in handling war supplies.

Labor trouble among the workers on the Mersey recently has caused serious embarrassment.

The battalion will be made up of about 2,000 union men, who will be enlisted under the military law, with army pay, in addition to a guaranteed minimum wage of thirty-five shillings weekly.
