

"IRISH REPUBLIC" WOULD INHERIT DEBT

NEW YORK, June 26.—If an Irish republic is established it will assume full responsibility for the \$500,000 Fenian bond issue, as yet unpaid, which was floated in the United States in 1866 on behalf of Ireland's case, it was announced here to-day by Eamonn de Valera SinnFein leader, who said he regarded these bonds as a "debt of honor."

G.W.V. Member Discusses Strike

SAYS "REDS" AND PROFIT-EERS THE DANGEROUS ONES

Winnipeg June 26.—In a statement issued to-night John Newton vice-president of the Winnipeg branch of the G.W.V.A. says:

"There are two main enemies to peace and prosperity in Canada to-day, one just as bad as the other and really of the same type viz., the profiteers among the capitalists and the Reds among labor. It is clearly the duty of the Great War Veterans Association to see that the activities of both are brought to a close."


"The strike has not been an unmixed evil by any manner of means. It has awakened the people from their apathetic slumbers. It has shown the Government that the problems of the undesirable alien, the profiteers and the high cost of living must be satisfactorily handled immediately and that if the present Government is unable to fill the bill another Government must take its place, in other words the present strike has focused public attention upon what the G.W.V.A. has been urging on the Government for months."

Liberty League to Oppose Work of L's Day Alliance

Recently Formed Organization Plans Whirlwind Campaign Against Lord's Day Alliances

WINDSOR, June 26.—Indications are that the Liberty League formed here with Mayor Charles King, of Walkerville, at its head, to oppose the activities of the Lord's Day Alliance, will soon become a whirlwind movement.

Already many prominent citizens have expressed themselves in sympathy with the objects of the new organization and a deputation has been named to wait on the Trades and Labor Council at its next meeting to enlist the aid of that body to further the movement.
