An Act to vest in the Municipal Councils of Parishes or Townships alone, the right of granting Licenses for keeping taverns and houses of public entertainment, and for the sale by retail of spirituous liquors.

HEREAS, with a view to the more effectual repression of intem- Preamble. perance, it is expedient to vest in the Municipal Councils of Parishes, Townships, or parts of Parishes or Townships, or of Towns or Villages, the powers now held by the County Councils, with reference to 5 the sale of spirituous liquors, the granting of licenses to storekeepers, tavern-keepers or others, for the sale of such liquors, as well as to the governing of such storekeepers, tavernkeepers and others; Therefore, Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

I. The powers granted to all County Councils by the eighth section of Powers grant-10 the Act passed in the nineteenth and twentieth years of Her Majesty's ed to County Reign, intituled "The Lower Canada Municipal and Road Amendment Lower Canada Act of 1856," and by any other Act, with reference to the sale of spirit- with regard to uous, vinous, alcoholic and intoxicating liquors, to the conditions and restrictions under which and to the manner in which all revenue inquors, trans15 spectors shall grant licenses to storekeepers, tavernkeepers or others for ferred to the the sale of such liquors, with reference also to the amount to be paid for cils; and every such license, and to the ordering and governing of all storekeepers, licenses granttavernkeepers and others selling such liquors, shall, from and after the ed contrary to passing of this Act, cease to be vested in the said County Councils, and the By-laws 20 shall thenceforward be vested exclusively in the Municipal Councils of Councils to be parishes, of townships, of parts of parishes or townships, or of towns or void. villages; and all licenses to whomsoever granted, either by a revenue inspector or by any other person authorised to that effect by competent authority, for the sale by retail of spirituous, vinous, alcoholic or intoxi-25 cating liquors of any kind whatsoever, in any place whatsoever in a local municipality, after the Municipal Council of that municipality shall have passed a By-law or By-laws determining under what conditions and restrictions and in what manner the revenue Inspector for the district shall grant such licenses, or absolutely prohibiting the granting of such 30 licenses, otherwise than in conformity with the By-law or By-laws of such local Council, shall be null and of no effect in law.

II. This Act shall apply only to Lower Canada.
