VII. And be it enacted, That the rents, issues and profits, sum Moneys of and sums of money by the said Royal Institution for the advance-Corporation not hereafter ment of Learning held and possessed or which may be by them to be paid to hereafter received, shall not be paid into the hands of the Receiver Receiver General. 5 General of this Province, but the same shall be received by the Treasurer of the said Royal Institution for the advancement of Learding, and be by him deposited and disposed of in such manner as, from time to time, the said Royal Institution for the advancement of Learning may direct; Provided always that the said Proviso annual accounts to be 10 Royal Institution for the advancement of Learning shall, on or furnished to in every year furnish to the the Governor. before the day of Governor of this Province, a detailed statement and account affirmed by the Treasurer before a Judge of any Court of Record, of the receipt and expenditure of such monies during the year

VIII. And be it enacted, That all such parts and provisions of the Provisions of said two Acts, inituled trespectively, "An Act for the establish-Acts, incomment of Free Schools and the advancement of Learning in this sistent with this Act re-Province," and " An Act to enable the Corporation of the Royal pealed. 20 Institution for the advancement of Learning to dispose of certain portions of land for the better support of the Universary of McGill College" as are repugnant to or in any manner inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed; -Provided always Provise: exthat nothing herein contained shall impair or affect any rights not impaired 25 heretofore acquired under and by virtue of the said Acts or either of them or any remedies or proceedings for the enforcement of or in relation to such rights; but all such rights, remedies and proceedings shall be and remain as if this Act had not been passed.

IX. And be it enacted, That this Act shall be a Public Act. Public Act.
