## BILL.

An Act to amend the Ordinance relating to the Longueuil and Chambly Turnpike Road.

THEREAS it is expedient to amend the Preamble. Ordinance of the Governor and Special Council of Lower Canada, passed in the fourth year of Her Majesty's Reign, and in-5 tituled, "An Ordinance for establishing and 4 Vict., c. 16, " maintaining better means of communication cited. "between the City of Montreal and Cham-"bly," in the manner hereinafter provided: Be it therefore enacted, &c.

10 And it is hereby enacted by the authority of Sections 11 and the same, That the eleventh and twelfth sec- 12 repealed. tions of the said Ordinance shall be and are hereby repealed; and that the tolls payable now Tolls under the said Ordinance, shall be pay-shall be pay-shall be pay-15 able one-half on passing and the other half on repassing, through all or any of the Turnpike gates on the roads in the said Ordinance mentioned: Provided always, that Proviso: all no carriage, animal or thing on which toll the gates may 20 shall have been paid, on any day, on passing payment of Toll at one. through any Turnpike gate on the said road, shall be subject to any further toll upon passing, on the same day and in the same direction, through any other Turnpike gate 25 on the said road.

II. Provided always, and be it enacted, commence-That this Act shall have force and effect her fine this upon, from and after the expiration of the now existing lease of the tolls under the said 30 Ordinance, made by The Trustees of the Longueuil and Chambly Turnpike Road to John Ryan, and not before.
