## BILL.

An Act to amend the Ordinance relating to the Longueuil and Chambly Turnpike Road.

**W**HEREAS it is expedient to amend the Ordinance of the Governor and Special Council of Lower Canada, passed in the fourth year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intitled, "*An Ordinance for establishing and maintaining better means of communication between the City of Montreal and Chambly,*" in the manner hereinafter provided: Be it therefore enacted, &c.

Preamble.

10 And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the eleventh and twelfth sections of the said Ordinance shall be and are hereby repealed; and that the tolls payable under the said Ordinance, shall be payable one-half on passing and the other half on repassing, through all or any of the Turnpike gates on the roads in the said Ordinance mentioned: Provided always, that no carriage, animal or thing on which toll shall have been paid, on any day, on passing through any Turnpike gate on the said road, shall be subject to any further toll upon passing, on the same day and in the same direction, through any other Turnpike gate on the said road.

Sections 11 and 12 repealed.

How Tolls shall be payable.

Proviso: all the gates may be passed on payment of Toll at once.

II. Provided always, and be it enacted, That this Act shall have force and effect upon, from and after the expiration of the now existing lease of the tolls under the said Ordinance, made by *The Trustees of the Longueuil and Chambly Turnpike Road* to John Ryan, and not before.
