Enclosed herewith is a blue print plan showing a short piece of road in the Sarcee reserve required by the Provincial Government. You will note that it leads from the South limit of the reserve at the N.W. corner of Sec.31, Tp.22, R.2, W.5.M., in a northerly direction to intersect the road allowance which has already been surveyed by the Provincial Government. Be good enough to report whether there is any objection to the transferring of this road to the Province and whether any charge should be made for the right of way or other arrangement regarding fencing etc.,

A surrender from the Indians in this matter is not required but it is desired that as usual you will consult them. The Department will however be guided by your own judgment and you should endeavour to induce the Indians to agree with your views.
