about the death of my youngest boy in
certain battle in France doing
his duty to his King and Empire
so that the old flag may not
fall. My children and myself
have agreed to put up a memorial
stone and statue at our family cemetery

the request of the Brotherhood
of Trainers from the City of St.
Thomas (where he was a member
at the time he enlisted in Aug 1914)
to put up a memorial stone we have

pit - not nearer than three or four
