Sir,

These minutes attached, embrace a variety of matters, of which, to the several cases pour revision of the census, your confirmation or otherwise, is respectfully requested, in order to complete the census before the first of January.

Referring to the Minutes:

To assist me in preparing a list of those who should receive a blanket, I invited the naming of a Committee of six chiefs for that purpose.

I read to the Council <sup>copy of</sup> the account current of the School Board to the 30th June last.

The Ontario Government sent to the Council for consideration and execution, an Indenture of Assurance <sup>or</sup> Agreement, <sup>in duplicate -</sup> in respect to the appropriation from the Municipal Loan Fund, and its expenditure upon the Grist and Saw Mill, and, for other purposes in behalf of the Six Nations.
