Ottawa, June 22nd, 1908.

Sir,-

I have to direct your attention to letter of the 23rd. of April which stated the terms under which you were engaged to value the Pine timber on the Hoki Indian Reserve. You were to be allowed two men whose wages were to be paid by the Department, and for \$20.00 a day you were to furnish food and complete outfit, etc. The Department is in receipt of your account amounting to \$721.60 for this service. It is observed that you have charged the wages of four men, and 18 days' board for John Fraser at 50¢ a day.

May I ask you to explain these charges in view of the terms under which you were engaged as specified by the letter above quoted.
