I may state shat when examining the chattel mortgage Inoliced that all the chattels were said to be typing or being in the Township of little Dubeaus Solicitor evidently overlooked this fact, or he would not have given me the answer he did. My opinion of the case is that there is not the slightest "evidence of fraud or unifair dealing on the part of Dubean; and that the Indian entered on an enterprise that turned out me -"profitably, and desires to except loss under ever of the 77 = section of the Indian Set."
